

- Local Police will identify crime issues that require circulation. These are passed to the Watch Co-ordinator, who works at Police Headquarters and then circulated via using the Watch messaging system. Messages can be sent to you by all the methods below. We prefer e-mail.
- If you have information about crimes or suspicious incidents that you want circulating you can send it to the Watch Co-ordinator and we will circulate it.

Surveys needed

The project will shortly be entering the pre-procurement phase and there is a need to have a big push on getting information about the real state of broadband provision across our area.

As you will be aware, telecoms providers will tell you that you can get broadband speeds of **up to** a certain speed, but we have examples where up to 10Mbps actually means less than 1Mbps.

The only way we will be able to show where an uplift is needed is to have evidence of real speeds and what broadband is being used for or may be used for in the future.
